<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Pens (blue or black - 2 packages) ● 3-5 red pens ● Highlighters (3 different colors) ● 2 packs of pencils (1 pack stays in Social Studies classroom) ● 1 pack of colored pencils ● Pencil sharpener with shaving cap (non-electric) ● Separate eraser (not the ones that go on pencil tops) ● 1 pair of scissors ● 2 packages of Post-It notes (sticky notes) ● 1 ruler with standard and metric measurements ● 1 protractor ● Headphones (label with name) ● 2 one-inch binders (1 for Religion, 1 for Spanish) ● 1 pack of dividers - 5 tab (for Spanish) ● 3 folders with 2 pockets and brads (2 for Literature, 1 for Religion) ● 5-6 composition notebooks (2 for Social Studies, 1 for Science, 1 for Grammar, 1 for STEM (new-students only), 1 for Religion—or you can reuse your Lectio journal from last year for religion if you have it) ● Spiral notebook with perforated sheets for math ● 1 medium-weight sketchbook size 9x11 with 50 sheets minimum (Art) ● 3 packs of notebook paper ● Pencil case ● Chromebook case - students will not be allowed to store it in their backpacks.
